**Goal:** In this advanced level studio course you will continue to develop your observational skills and take on more choice in media you use. You will take on an active role in your development as an artist, in part by taking on increasingly challenging projects that require more time and commitment to your artistic practice. Projects will still aim to develop skills in composition, rendering and color theory, but you will play a role in shaping your projects. This course is designed to meet the needs of students wishing to prepare a portfolio for applying to art school or prepare to take Advanced Placement Studio Art. You will look at art by many artists for each major project we do. The writing you do for each artist study will be submitted via **Turn It In**.
